## Arrival from Frankfurt Airport

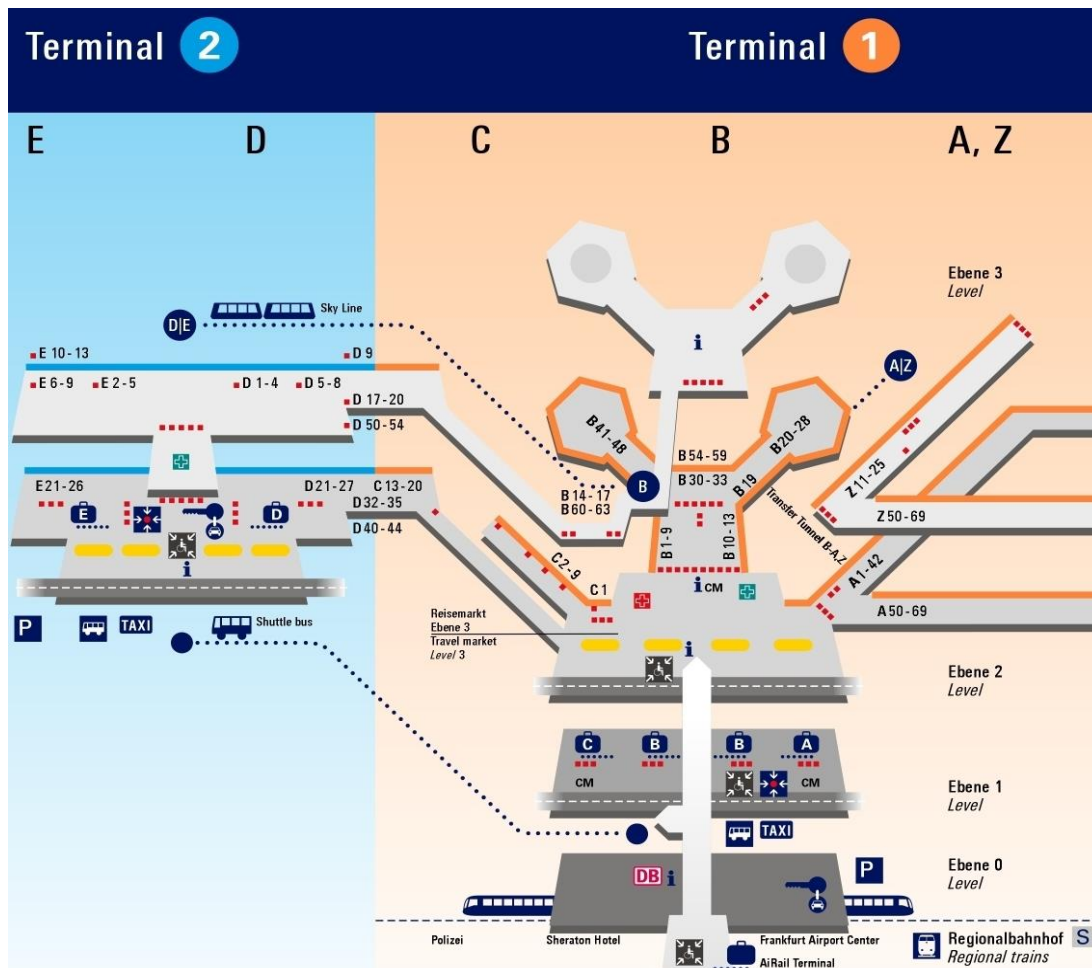
(Terminal 2)

In order to get to the local railroad station at the Frankfurt Airport, take the **Sky Line** from Terminal 2 to Terminal 1. Just follow the signs saying 'Terminal 1 via Sky Line'. The Sky Line - a free shuttle train between two terminals - will take you to Terminal 1.

Intervals: Every 2 – 3 minutes.

Station of departure: Terminal 2: Level 4, in the center of the terminal

Arrival station: Terminal 1: Departure Hall B, Level 4



In Terminal 1, Level 4, follow the signs for Train Stations S on Level-1 in order to reach the local railroad station.



From Platform 3 of the local railroad station Frankfurt Airport you can take the following trains to Hauptbahnhof Mainz:

- **S-Bahn 8 to Wiesbaden** or
- **RE to Koblenz** or **Saarbrücken**

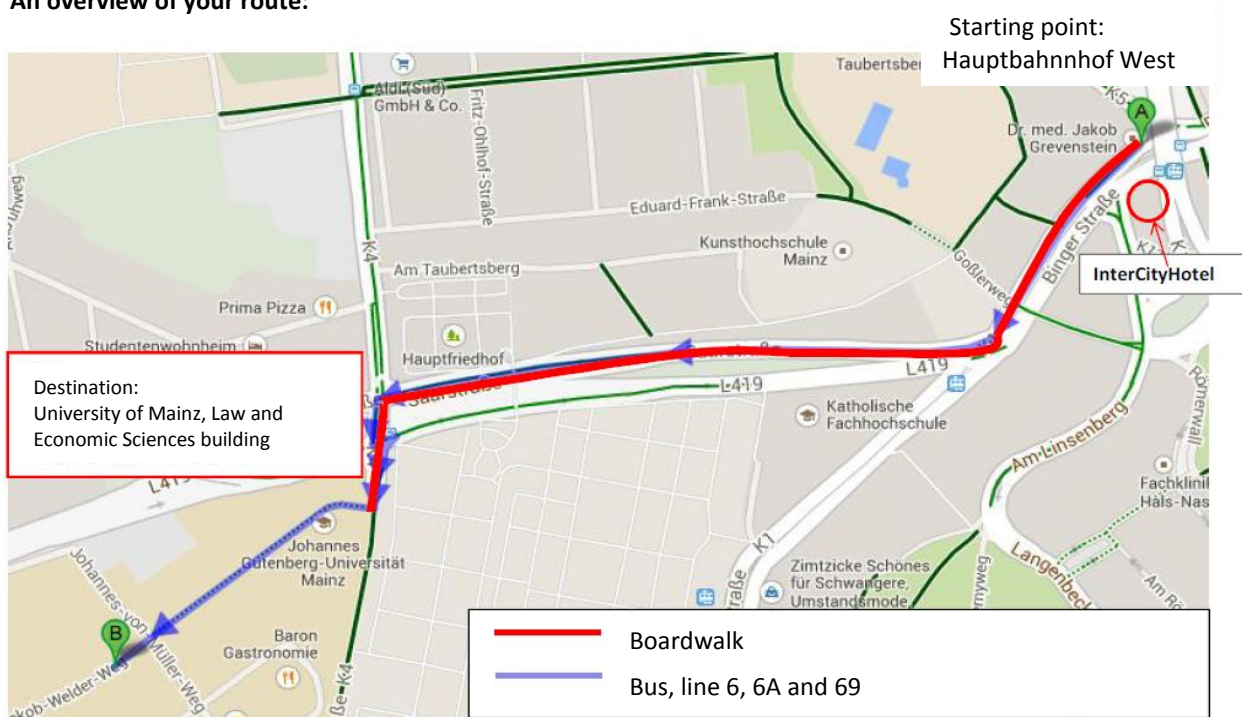

- Journey time about 26 minutes.

From the platform, you can get to the station building by taking the stairs. Your exit is **Hauptbahnhof West**.



Once you have left the station building, a path underneath a bridge will lead you directly to the **bus stop Hauptbahnhof West/Taubertsbergbad**.

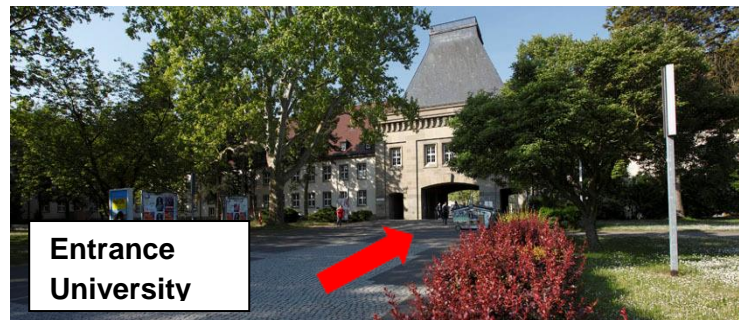
From the bus stop Hauptbahnhof West /Taubertsbergbad you can get to the Johannes Gutenberg University by taking one of these busses:



- 6** to Marienborn/Pfarrer-Dorn-Straße,
- 6A** to Bretzenheim/Gutenberg-Center,
- 69** to Universität/Campus/Fachhochschule

You will reach the Johannes Gutenberg-University after just one stop.

From the bus stop you can enter the grounds of the University of Mainz by passing through the two archways of the Forum.



On your left side you can see the "Alte Mensa". This is where the registration takes place.
