The submitted proposals will be reviewed by peers, and those accepted will be confirmed by **January 20, 2011**.



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Form and style of the proposal

The extended summary (400–600 words) should describe the following details of the project or study:

- Research questions
- Theoretical background of the research
- Research design
- Results
- Significance in the field of modeling and measurement of competencies in higher education

The **English Posters** should be in DIN A0 (84.1 x 118.9 cm)
